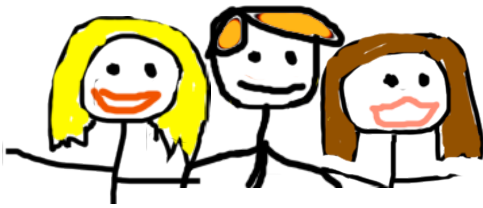
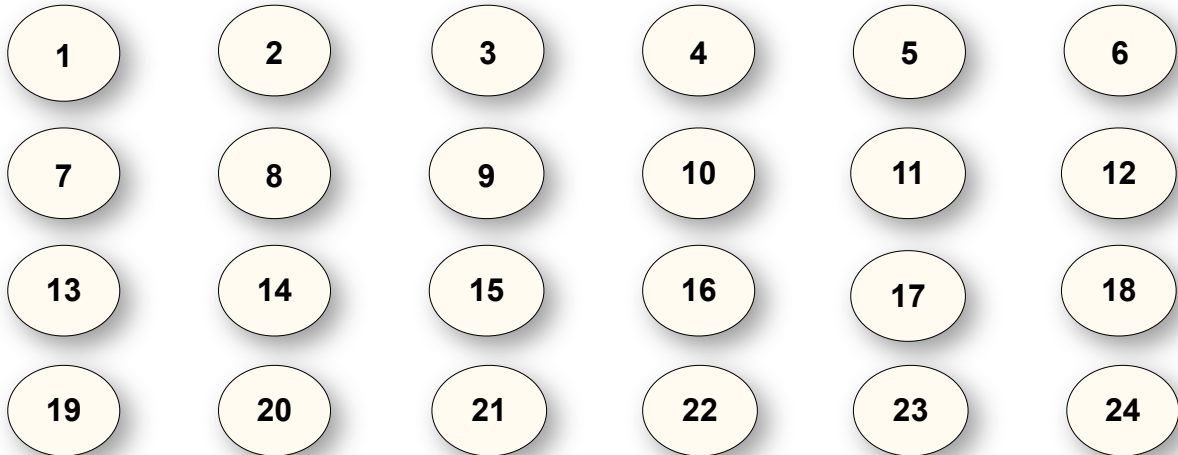


EnglishClip 5 - The Memory Game
